

INHALATION: IF BOTHERSOME REMOVE TO FRESH AIR. IF VICTIM IS NOT BREATHING, START CPR AND SEEK MEDICAL ATTENTION IMMEDIATELY

EYES: REMOVE CONTACT LENSES IF PRESENT, FLUSH WITH WATER (15 MIN) IF IRRITATION APPARENT CONTACT PHYSICIAN.

SKIN: REMOVE CONTAMINATED CLOTHING AND SHOES. FLUSH WITH WATER IF IRRITATION IS APPARENT CALL A PHYSICIAN

INGESTING: DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING. IF PERSON IS CONSCIOUS HAVE THEM DRINK LARGE VOLUMES OF MILK OR WATER, CALL PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY

SECTION VI: REACTIVITY DATA

STABILITY DATA: PRODUCT IS STABLE

INCOMPATIBILITY: STRONG OXIDIZERS i.e. PERMANGANATE

HAZARDOUS DECOMPOSITION PRODUCT: MAY LIBERATE CARBON MONOXIDE AND CARBON DIOXIDE

HAZARDOUS POLYMERIZATION: WILL NOT OCCUR

SECTION VII: SPILL OR LEAK PROCEDURES

SMALL SPILLS: WIPE UP PRODUCT, RINSE SOILED AREA WITH WATER DOWN DRAIN.

LARGE SPILLS: STOP LEAK AT THE SOURCE AND COLLECT INTO A SUITABLE CONTAINER THEN TREAT AS A SMALL SPILL. FOLLOW STATE AND LOCAL REGULATIONS FOR DISPOSAL OF NON-RECLAIMABLE SPILLS.

PRECAUTIONS TO BE TAKEN IN HANDLING AND STORAGE: ALWAYS STORE UNUSED PORTION IN ORIGINAL CONTAINER WITH CAP SECURE. AVOID TEMPERATURE EXTREMES.

OTHER PRECAUTIONS: AS WITH ALL CHEMICALS USE DUE CARE ACCORDING TO LABEL INSTRUCTION AND PRECAUTIONS.

SECTION VIII: SPECIAL PROTECTION

EYE PROTECTION: SAFETY GLASSES WITH SIDE SHIELDS, CHEMICAL GOGGLES RECOMMENDED SHOULD BE WORN DURING TRANSFER, MISTING, SPRAYING OR WHERE SPLASHING MAY OCCUR
